**How Do I Get There?** The NCAC and Amangamek Wipit Lodge of the Order of the Arrow will provide free bus service from a site in Northern Virginia. This site will be located based on pre-registration response. It is very important to pre-register so that the Lodge can contract for appropriate bus service. The Virginia West Area and Associated Chapters (Bull Run, Goose Creek, Piedmont, and Sully) will attempt to arrange car pools and rides to the bus loading point, if you need this. We will contact everyone via email with the appropriate bus loading location and time.

**What Do I Bring as an Ordeal Candidate?** You MUST have with you a sleeping bag, ground cloth (in addition to a tent ground cloth), poncho/rain gear (if not using a poncho – bring a 2<sup>nd</sup> ground cloth), personal toiletries, full uniform, non-uniform work clothes, work gloves, pocket knife and a bag dinner for Friday night if you have not already eaten before arriving. NO FOOD WILL BE SERVED ON FRIDAY NIGHT! You must arrange to have a your own tent (if you don't have one – arrange to borrow a troop tent) one tent per person. Please bring with you as many of the following tools as you can, BUT MAKE SURE THEY ARE WELL MARKED WITH YOUR NAME -- the OA takes no responsibility for lost tools: rakes, hoes, shovels, picks, tree/shrub shears, bow saws. <u>You would also be well advised to bring some extra cash with you</u> for the trading post, which will be available where additional OA items can be purchased.

**What Should I Leave At Home?** DO NOT bring any electronic equipment such as radios, GameBoys, boom boxes etc. They are not needed and they will be confiscated and returned to you after the Ordeal!

Is There A Cost And Must I Pre-Register? Yes, there is a cost and you must pre-register <u>BY FRIDAY</u>

<u>May 9<sup>TH</sup></u> using the tear-off registration form below. The cost is \$47.00 for the weekend for Ordeal candidates (this covers your

food, insurance, OA sash, OA handbook, one Lodge flap, dues through 2003, etc.) and \$35 for Brotherhood candidates (this covers your food, insurance, new sash, etc.). Members who will staff the weekend and who will not be converting will pay \$25.00. For those Ordeal members who wish to relive their Ordeal experience in the service to the Ordeal candidates as Elangomats and achieve their Brotherhood conversion, the weekend is FREE in recognition of their commitment to serve IF THEY HAVE PRE-ARRANGED their service with the Area Chief. Brotherhood members who serve as Elangomats will also attend the Ordeal for FREE IF THEY HAVE PRE-ARRANGED their service with the Area Chief.
